**Parents must not coach their players in any way from the stands.** If you have something to suggest, please quietly direct the question to one of the coaches on the field. We encourage you to cheer or yell praises to the players on the field. Any parent in violation of this rule will be given one warning. The next offense, they will be asked to leave the ball field area immediately. On the third offense, the parent will be suspended or banned for at least three games meaning they will not be permitted to be in any surrounding area of the field during the game. On the fourth offense, the player of that parent will be removed from the team roster.

**Parents must never yell negative statements at their player or any other player on the field, in the dugout, or anywhere near the playing field.** Please let the coaches on the field coach, correct or direct your players. If you have any areas you'd like to coaches to work on, please discuss it with the coaches. Game time is not the time to yell or harshly coach your player. Any parent in violation of this rule will be given one warning. The next offense, they will be asked to leave the ball field area immediately. On the third offense, the parent will be suspended or banned for at least three games meaning they will not be permitted to be in any surrounding area of the field during the game. On the fourth offense, the player of that parent will be removed from the team roster.

**Parents must never complain or make any negative comments about the coach, the manager, nor the umpires during a game or practice.** If you have some concerns, please address them directly and professionally to the manager of the team or one of the field coaches. The field coaches will relay the information or concern to the manager. The best way to get action is to handle things professionally, including using the proper protocol to address umpires. **Only** the manager is permitted to address an umpire per the league and tournament rules. Any parent in violation of this rule will be given one warning. The next offense, they will be asked to leave the ball field area immediately. On the third offense, the parent will be suspended or banned for at least three games meaning they will not be permitted to be in any surrounding area of the field during the game. On the fourth offense, the player of that parent will be removed from the team roster.

**Players must never throw any bats, helmets, gloves or anything while on the playing field.** A player will receive one warning. (The umpire may eject the player.) On the second offense, the player will be benched for the remainder of the game. On the third offense, the player will be suspended for at least three games. On the fourth offense, the player will be removed from the team roster.

**Players must never intentionally hit or push another player on the team.** A player will receive one warning. On the second offense, the player will be removed from the roster. We are aware that some players will be goofing around and accidents can happen. We are talking here about very obvious intent to harm a player that has to be seen by a manager or coach and preferably at least one other independent coach or parent (whose player was not involved) that can confirm the action.

**Players must never yell any disrespectful statements to coaches or umpires during games.** On the first offense, the player will be benched for the remainder of the game. On the second offense, the player will be suspended for at least three games. On the third offense, the player will be removed from the team roster.

If at anytime, a parent refuses to quietly leave the field area when asked by the manager due to a violation of one of the above rules, the player will be removed from the roster immediately.

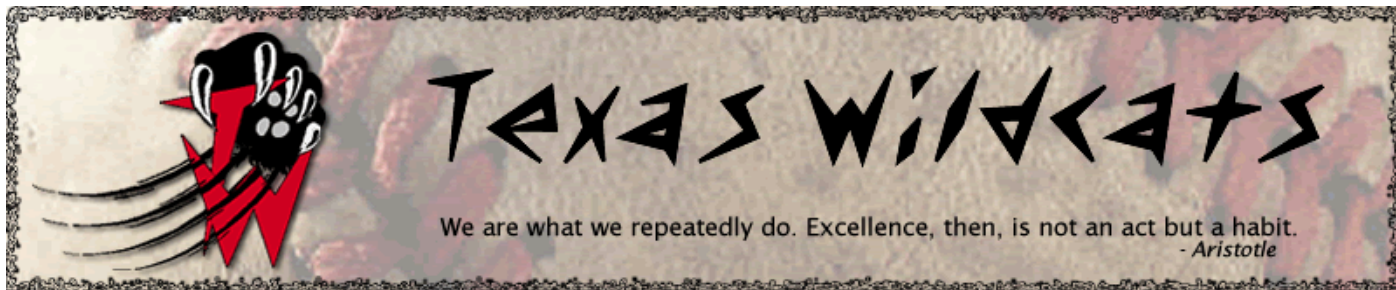
